

From Mayor McNabb...

I would like to begin by congratulating Jeff Hooker on his one-year anniversary with the City. Jeff has done a great job learning about and serving the City.

We continue to have Covid issues within the City. Almost every department has had quarantines and positive cases. Our employees have done a great job stepping up when their departments are short staffed. Let me remind you to take whatever steps you are comfortable with to protect yourselves, your families and your neighbors as we work through these times.

Our Airport project continues to move forward as we near the final phase of grading of taxiways and paving the 5,000-foot runway and taxiways. We hope to have this project finished in 2021. The Board of Aldermen has voted to move into the blueprint and construction document phase of the Community Center. If those documents are approved we could begin construction in early summer.

In early February we will be accepting bids on several spring and summer projects. In Public Works we have a waterline replacement and several street overlays. One of those road projects is to replace the center drive in the Blair Cemetery.

Parks will be taking bids to refurbish the slide and water bubbler features at the city pool. Parks department is also preparing for summer activities such as the youth ball leagues. We are also happy to announce our partnership with the Camden County Library to furnish wi-fi at the park around Pam May Drive.

Police Chief Beauchamp has begun his duties and things are running smoothly with some minor changes in the department. I would also congratulate Sergeants Sansom and Brown on their promotions. Finally I would like to welcome Jessica Baughman to the patrol staff.

There are many new businesses coming to Camdenton, we wish them all success, along with the many established businesses in the community. Our sales tax revenues continue to do well.

Finally, I appreciate the support I have received as Mayor and I consider it a great honor to serve the people and the community. I have no agenda but to do my best to help the city grow and thrive. City Staff is here to serve the people.

City Wide Garage Sale & Residential Clean Up COMING SOON!

The City of Camdenton is planning for the 11th Annual City-Wide Garage Sale. The Garage Sale is planned for Friday, June 4, 2021 and Saturday, June 5, 2021 with the annual Residential Clean Up the following week of June 7-11, 2021 on your regular trash pickup day. **More information will be in the May Newsletter.**

The City will be waiving the garage sale permit requirement for June 4-5 only! This is a great way to pass on those "previously loved items" in addition to cleaning up the residential areas of our town.

HAVE YOU LICENSED YOUR PET FOR 2021?

Public safety for the citizens of Camdenton is our number one priority. This is the reason it is so important for all citizens to license their pets. Section 210.090 of City Code requires all pet owners residing in the city to license all dogs and cats over six months of age. Licenses shall be effective from January 1st to December 31st of each year. Camdenton does have a leash law which is enforced. If you are licensing your pet after January 31 a penalty is applied. The cost is \$20 for a spay/neutered pet or \$50 for a non-spay/non-neutered pet.

You may come to City Hall during normal business hours, Monday through Friday, 8 am until 4:30 pm to obtain your licenses. You will need to bring proof of current rabies vaccinations and spay/neuter information.

Your pet is an important part of your family and City Officials understand that bond. For the safety of your pet and the safety of your neighbors it is important to license your animals. This allows us to identify animals and to return them to their owners if they are lost. We understand that they can escape your home or yard and we want to assist in getting them home.

If you know of an animal running loose in your neighborhood, please call City Hall at 573-346-3600 and report the information. Please protect our pets and help us to keep our neighborhoods safe. As always, we are here to assist you in any way we can, call if you have questions or concerns.

ANNUAL LIFE SAFETY INSPECTIONS FOR BUSINESSES

Businesses within the City of Camdenton are required to renew their business license each year by June 1. Renewal notices for businesses are mailed out in early April each year and are due by May 30 each year. A penalty will be applied for license renewals received after June 1 each year. As a friendly reminder, <u>ALL BUSINESSES</u> (new & those renewing) are <u>REQUIRED</u> to have an <u>ANNUAL LIFE SAFETY INSPECTION APPROVED BY THE CODE & FIRE OFFICIAL BEFORE THEIR BUSINESS LICENSE WILL BE ISSUED!</u>

IT IS THE BUSINESS OWNERS RESPONSIBILTY TO CONTACT CODE & FIRE OFFICIAL CHASITY IVEY TO SCHEDULE THEIR ANNUAL LIFE SAFETY INSPECTION, 573-346-3600 ext. 233 or civey@camdentoncity.com. Your business license/renewal will not be valid until the Annual Life Safety Inspection is completed. This inspection is for the protection of you and your customers. 
