

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CAMDENTON TITLE II: PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY & WELFARE; CHAPTER 210: PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO ALL ANIMALS; SECTION 210.090: ANIMAL LICENSING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF CAMDENTON, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Section 211.070.C of the Camdenton City Code is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 211.070.C:

C. The City may refuse to issue animal licenses to persons who:

1. Have been charged with animal abuse, neglect or cruelty while such charges are pending; or
2. Have been convicted of animal abuse, neglect or cruelty or have pled guilty to such offenses; or
3. Have willfully failed to maintain licenses for animals within the City of Camdenton in the past; or
4. Have been charged with or convicted of violations of this or other portions of the City of Camdenton Code which involve dangerous, unlicensed, unsanitary or other conduct involving animals.
5. Occupy premises that are also owned or occupied by any person with any of the above situations.
- 6. Are attempting to license an animal that would cause them to be in violation of City Code.**
6. 7. In the event that a license is denied to any person under this section, they may appeal this decision to the Animal Control Board within a period of ten (10) days after such denial.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its approval by the Board of Aldermen and approval by the Mayor.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
