

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2086-05 – TO OPT OUT OF THE STATE IMPOSED SALES TAX HOLIDAY

WHEREAS, on October 18, 2005 the City executed Ordinance No. 2086-05 to opt out of the State imposed Sales Tax Holiday; and

WHEREAS, the current Board of Aldermen wish to repeal that ordinance and observe the Sales Tax Holiday effective immediately.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF CAMDENTON, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Board of Alderman hereby repeals Ordinance No. 2086-05 in its entirety.

Section 2. The City of Camdenton hereby determines that it will allow for the provisions of RSMo Section 144.049 for the exemption of sales tax on certain clothing, personal computers, school supplies that occurs within the boundaries of the City of Camdenton beginning at 12:01 AM on the first Friday in August and ending at midnight on the Sunday following.


Section 3. The City Clerk is hereby directed to send written notice to the State of Missouri, Department of Revenue as soon as possible, but no later than June 15, 2019, of the decision to repeal the previous ordinance by forwarding a cover letter and certified copy of this Ordinance.

Section 4. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Board of Aldermen and approval by this Mayor.
