

From Mayor McNabb...

While this time of year is a little slower around City Hall, planning for the next nine months has really picked up. The Dogwood Festival, summer ball leagues, the City pool and the Airshow are all topics of discussion and committees are beginning to make plans. Summer projects for Public Works and the Police Department are also taking shape.

Bids will soon be going out for utility projects. We are also preparing for a major overlay project of Business Route 5 from the North City limits all the way through town to the South City limits. This involves a \$500,000 CBDG, while it may be an inconvenience for a few days, it will be worth it. We will also have some other overlays and water and sewer line replacements going on.

Covid continues to be a problem in all our departments. I appreciate the willingness of staff to help out whenever needed. We still have vacancies in several departments but have been able to bring on some new staff recently which has been a big help.

In January we had two retirements of City staff. I would like to recognize Larry Bennett, Park Director and Milton Webster, Water Department Crew Leader for their years of service to the community. We wish them well in their retirement.

Two major construction projects are finishing up in the City. Kwik-Car should be open in the next few weeks. The Veterans Clinic is hoping to be open by April 1. I am proud to welcome the clinic and the services they will provide to our local veterans, as well as veterans all over Mid-Missouri. We have several other projects in the beginning stages that will also help our community grow.

The Airport is open, and we are seeing an increase in traffic. The final taxiway phase will be completed in early Spring and will conclude the project. These improvements will bring more people and economic growth to the entire lake area.

I remind you that City staff is here to serve the people of our community. If we can help in anyway give us a call or stop in for a visit.

City Wide Garage Sale & Residential Clean Up COMING SOON!

The City of Camdenton is planning for the 11th Annual City-Wide Garage Sale. The Garage Sale is planned for Friday, June 3, 2022 and Saturday, June 4, 2022 with the annual Residential Clean Up the following week of June 6-10, 2022 on your regular trash pickup day. **More information will be in the May Newsletter.**

The City will be waiving the garage sale permit requirement for June 3-4 only! This is a great way to pass on those "previously loved items" in addition to cleaning up the residential areas of our town.

HAVE YOU LICENSED YOUR PET FOR 2022?

Public safety for the citizens of Camdenton is our number one priority. This is the reason it is so important for all citizens to license their pets. Section 210.090 of City Code requires all pet owners residing in the city to license all dogs and cats over six months of age. Licenses shall be effective from January 1st to December 31st of each year. Camdenton does have a leash law which is enforced. A penalty is applied after January 31st. The cost is \$20 for a spay/neutered pet or \$50 for a non-spay/non-neutered pet.

You may come to City Hall during normal business hours, Monday through Friday, 8 am until 4:30 pm to obtain your licenses. You will need to bring proof of current rabies vaccinations and spay/neuter information.

Your pet is an important part of your family and City Officials understand that bond. For the safety of your pet and the safety of your neighbors it is important to license your animals. This allows us to identify animals and to return them to their owners if they are lost. We understand that they can escape your home or yard and we want to assist in getting them home.

If you know of an animal running loose in your neighborhood, please call City Hall at 573-346-3604 and report the information. Please protect our pets and help us to keep our neighborhoods safe. As always, we are here to assist you in any way we can, call if you have questions or concerns.

ANNUAL LIFE SAFETY INSPECTIONS FOR BUSINESSES

Businesses within the City of Camdenton are required to renew their business license each year by June 1. Renewal notices for businesses are mailed out in early April each year and are due by May 30 each year. A penalty will be applied for license renewals received after June 1 each year. As a friendly reminder, <u>ALL BUSINESSES</u> (new & those renewing) are <u>REQUIRED</u> to have an <u>ANNUAL LIFE SAFETY INSPECTION APPROVED BY THE CODE & FIRE OFFICIAL BEFORE THEIR</u> <u>BUSINESS LICENSE WILL BE ISSUED!</u>



PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUCEMENT

Laclede Electric Cooperative has informed the City that they have contracted with Lee Inspection & Consulting Services, Inc to perform inline pole inspections to identify eroding or failing poles for the purpose of replacement. They will be in the following areas in the City of Camdenton: North portion of the City of Camdenton (North Highway 5), Downtown and the West areas of Camdenton (East and West Highway 54).

Laclede Electric Cooperative's name and logo will identify the contracted vehicles. Each inspector will carry a Laclede Electric photo identification card that they will be happy to show upon request. CAMDENTON PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

RIGHT-OF-WAY WORK PERMITS

The right-of-way or roadway is the full width of the roads in the City. Most roads are 50 to 60 feet wide with the center 20 feet paved. This means there is 10 to 20 feet on either side of the asphalt that is still roadway. These areas are used for official signage and utilities.

Work such as driveways require permission and a permit issued by the City. City ordinances prohibit placing any materials, signs, or structures within the right-of-way. This includes real estate signs, political signs, and portable basketball goals. While we want our children to exercise, basketball goals left in the right-of-way become a traffic hazard and the owner of the goal is responsible should accidents happen. Please ensure the goals are moved back from the right-of-way after play.

If you plan on working close to the edge of the asphalt, please call City Hall at 573-346-3600 and we will be happy to help you.
