

CITY OF CAMDENTON
REGULAR SESSION MINUTES
NOVEMBER 5, 2019 – 6:00 PM

The Board of Aldermen of the City of Camdenton, met in Regular Session this 5 day of October 2019, City Hall, 437 West U.S. Highway 54, Camdenton, Missouri, with Mayor John McNabb presiding. A. Fill Vacant Park Crew Leader Position

Mr. Palmer will have a start date of November 6, 2019 with starting wage of \$15.50 per hour with full benefits, contingent upon successful post offer job skill testing and drug screening. C. Request by Camdenton Chamber and Art Council

Public Works Director Bill Jeffries attended the Christmas on the Square meeting at the Camdenton Chamber. The Art Council has painted scenes for display on the square and have requested that on the Southeast Quadrant some of the barberry plants be removed as they will be blocking the view of the displays. The displays are approximately 8' long and 4' tall. There will be flood lights to illuminate the scenes. By consensus of the Board Public Works Director Jeffries will remove any necessary barberry plants.
